

Short Term Rentals

contact: Case Managers and Discharge Planners

Many times a disability is only short term due to an accident. Make available the option to rent a ramp.

Rehab Hospitals

contact: Discharge Planner

Many do not think about the primary as well as a secondary exit to a residence until a patient is ready to be discharged. Save them time and money by installing a modular ramp without the long lead times and delays normally required by contractors for permanent ramps.

Insurance Companies

contact: Case Managers

Insurance companies are dealing with both long and short term disabilities. Many case managers are looking for a ramp that can be moved with the client if there is a residence change or are looking for a short term rental for a client that will only require the use of a ramp on a temporary basis.

City & Township Voting Sites

contact: City or Township Manager or Board of Elections

Every polling location is required to be accessible for voting only a couple of days a year. Ideal for a ramp that can be set up and removed quickly. Renting ramps may be an option.

Schools & Colleges

contact: Facilities Manager or Director of the Physical Plant

Point out the fact that the ramps can be relocated at different buildings as the student moves through their educational system or multiple ramps may be needed for all buildings in the campus. Not only may the students may be physically challenged, but the parents and visitors also. Consider the need of a short term use of a ramp for graduation ceremonies.

For schools and colleges an A*COM Commercial System may be necessary.
